


EARTHQUAKE INTENSITY
The Modified Mercalli (MMI) Intensity Scale

- 8** Damage slight in specially designed structures; considerable damage in ordinary substantial buildings with partial collapse. Damage great in poorly built structures. Fall of chimneys, factory stacks, columns, monuments, walls. Heavy furniture overturned.
- 7** Felt by all, many frightened. Some heavy furniture moved; a few instances of fallen plaster. Damage slight.
- 6** Damage negligible in buildings of good design and construction; slight to moderate in well-built ordinary structures; considerable damage in poorly built or badly designed structures; some chimneys broken.
- 5** Felt by nearly everyone; many awakened. Some dishes, windows broken. Unstable objects overturned. Pendulum clocks may stop.
